We have a full day of programming which is scheduled to begin promptly at 9:30 AM. in **Room E2.002 of the Legislative Conference Center on the second floor of the Capitol Extension.** This room number will be important should you need to request directions. Plan your arrival time at the State Capitol to include time for walking to the State Capitol, clearing security and walking to the State Capitol Extension.

Both the security checkpoints and the elevators may be crowded so allow time for these considerations.

On-site Registration and distribution of conference materials will begin at 9:00 AM.

To insure a comfortable and pleasant ride, two buses have been chartered; and bus assignments have been made to speed the boarding process. Bring a pillow if you wish.

The buses will depart for Austin promptly at **5:30** AM from the D/FW MSDC's parking lot at 8828 Stemmons Freeway. Parking lot security has been retained. Participants riding the chartered buses must check-in and board by 5:15 AM to facilitate an on-time departure from Dallas and an on-time arrival in Houston.
